**Grand Forks International Airport**

Grand Forks, ND: The Grand Forks Regional Airport Authority is pleased to announce the addition of two additional jet flights to Minneapolis, resulting in seven daily flights, increasing the seat capacity by 26 percent daily (72 seats per day). This announcement is as a result of a team effort between Delta Air Lines, the Grand Forks Regional Airport Authority and the Greater Grand Forks Region Economic Development Corporation.

We would like to thank Richard Anderson and the Staff at Delta for their continued support of the Grand Forks International Airport. They worked very hard to put together a schedule that will allow much better connection times, through Minneapolis, to both east and westbound destination.

We have reason to believe that this is the best Minneapolis hub schedule in North Dakota. It will provide our business and leisure customers with improved connection times, more chances to get back to Grand Forks, as well as, providing a full business day for people traveling to do business in Grand Forks. The addition of the 5:15 PM departure, from Minneapolis to Grand Forks, allows business travelers a full business day in the Twin Cities and to be home in time for dinner.

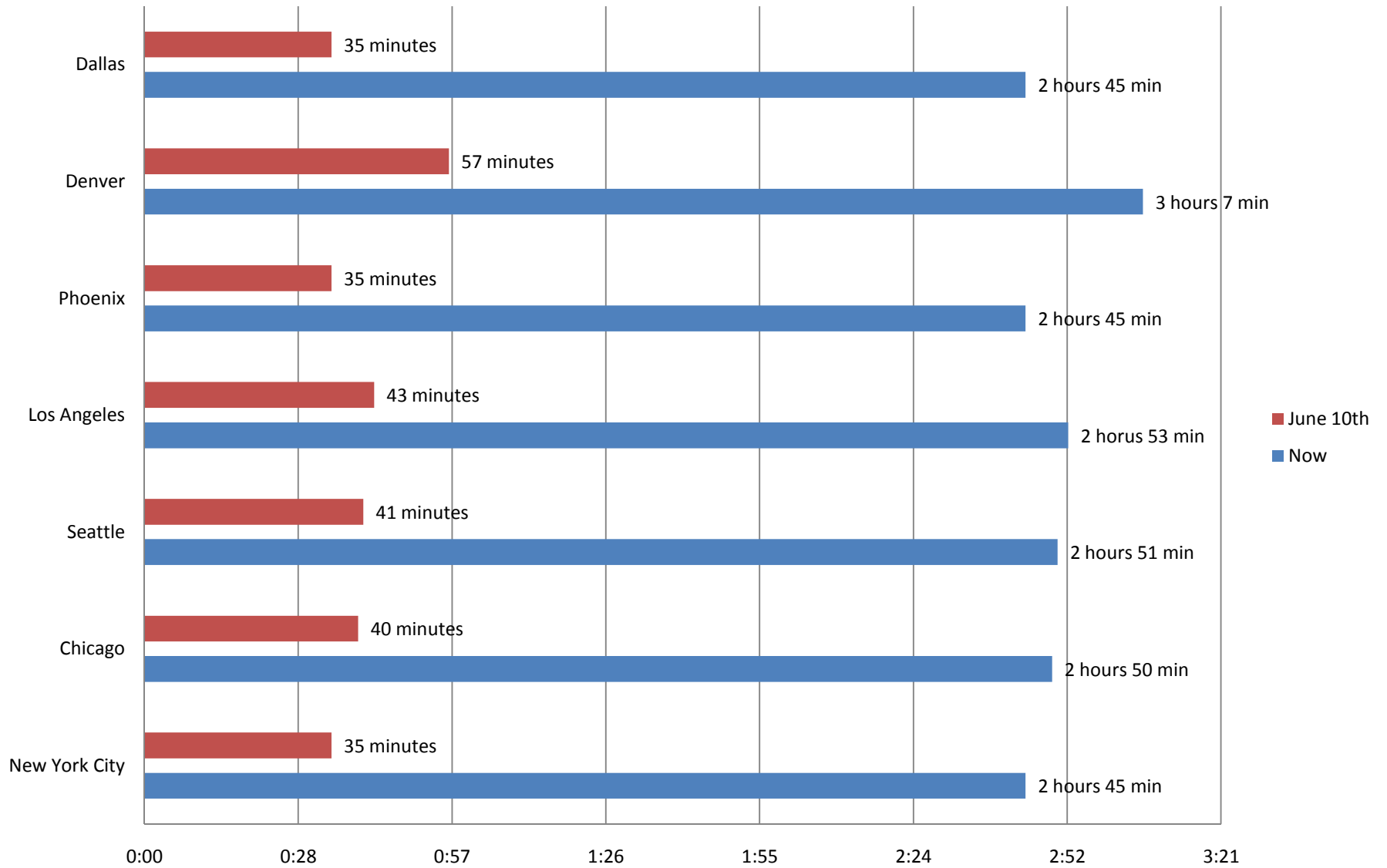
We would like to send a special thanks to Senator Dorgan and Governor Hoeven for their assistance and support in the air service improvements for Grand Forks.

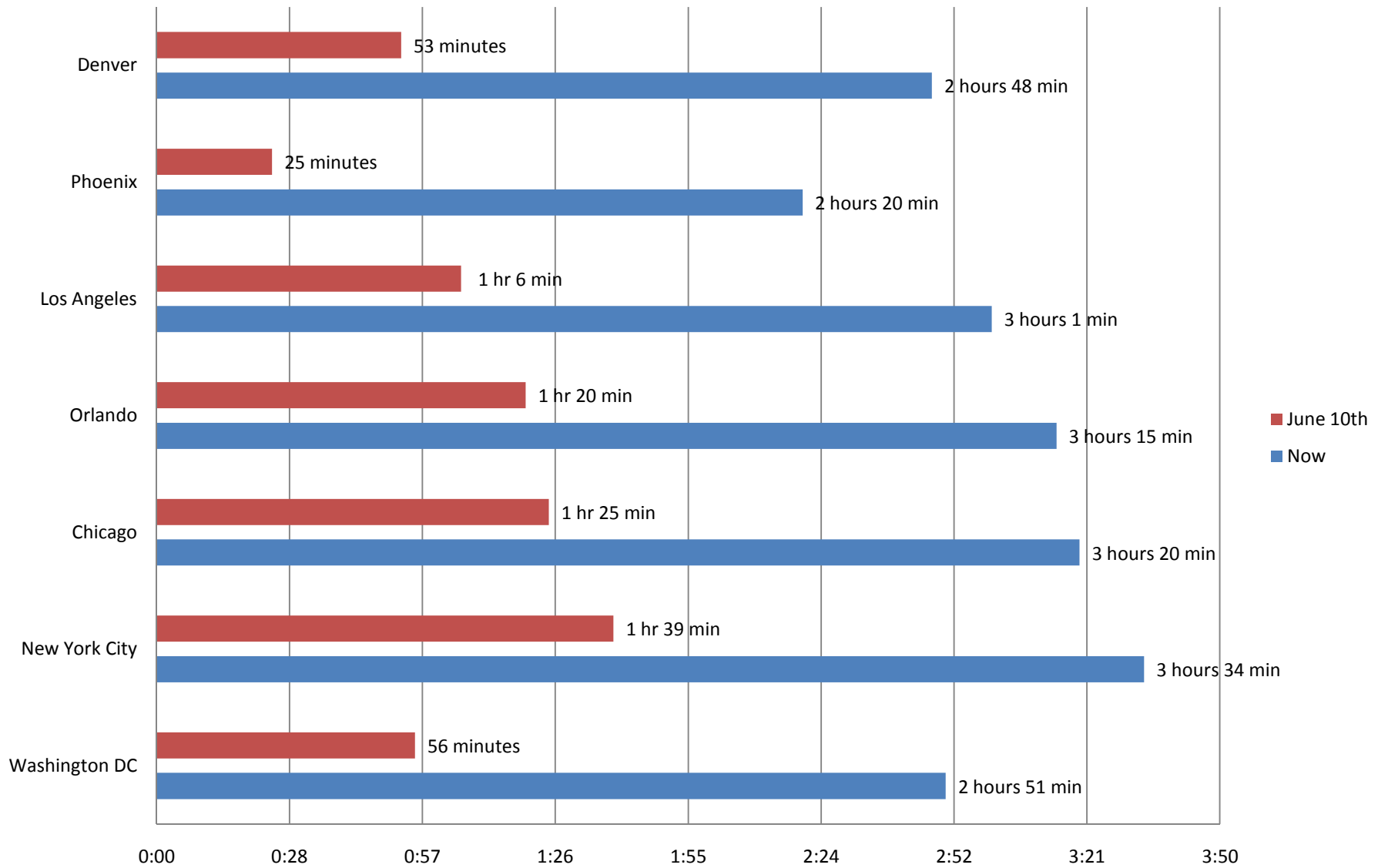

The additional service will begin on June 10, 2010 and customers will be able to start booking their travel March 13, 2010.

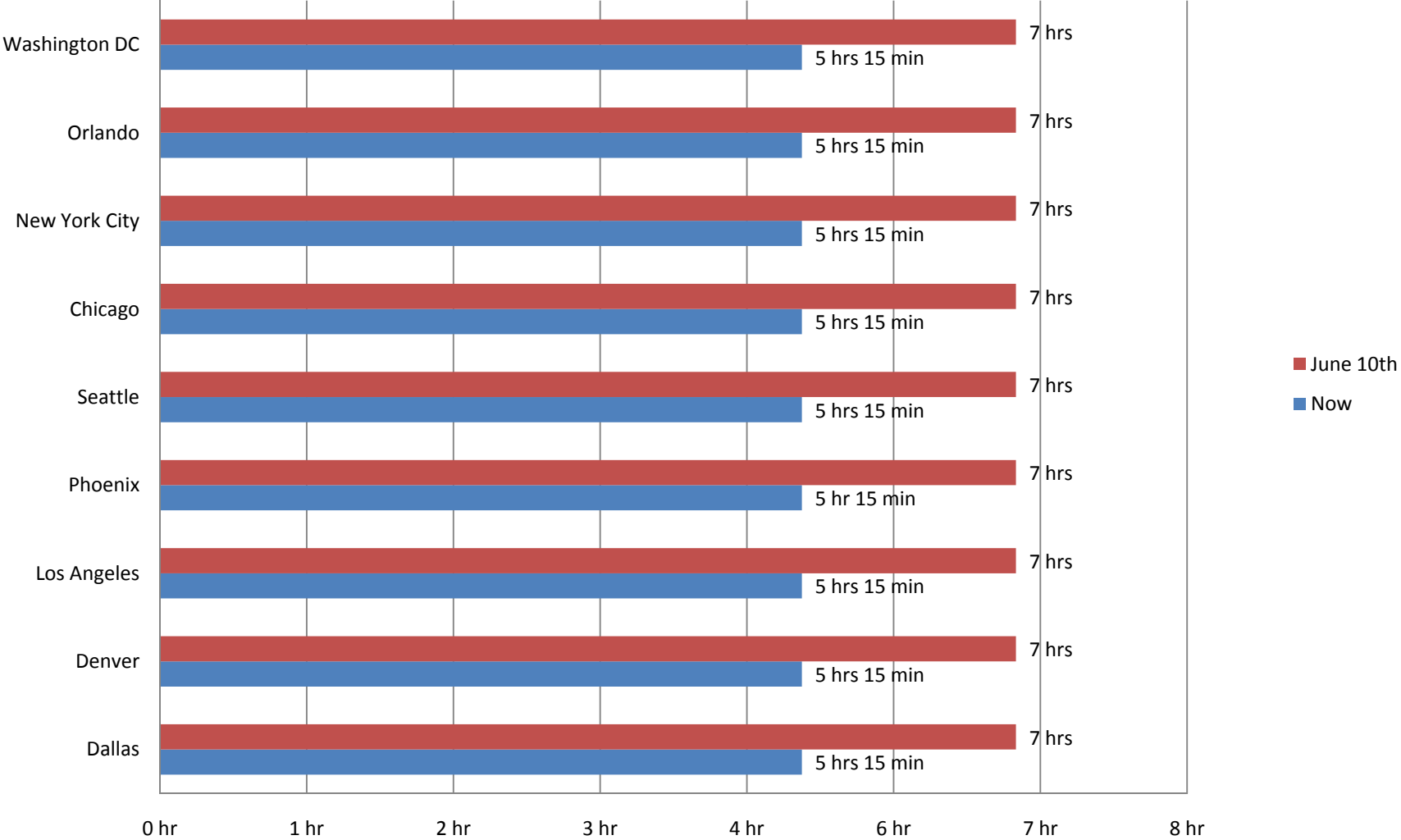
## Connection Times Decrease with Addition of 2:18 pm Arrival



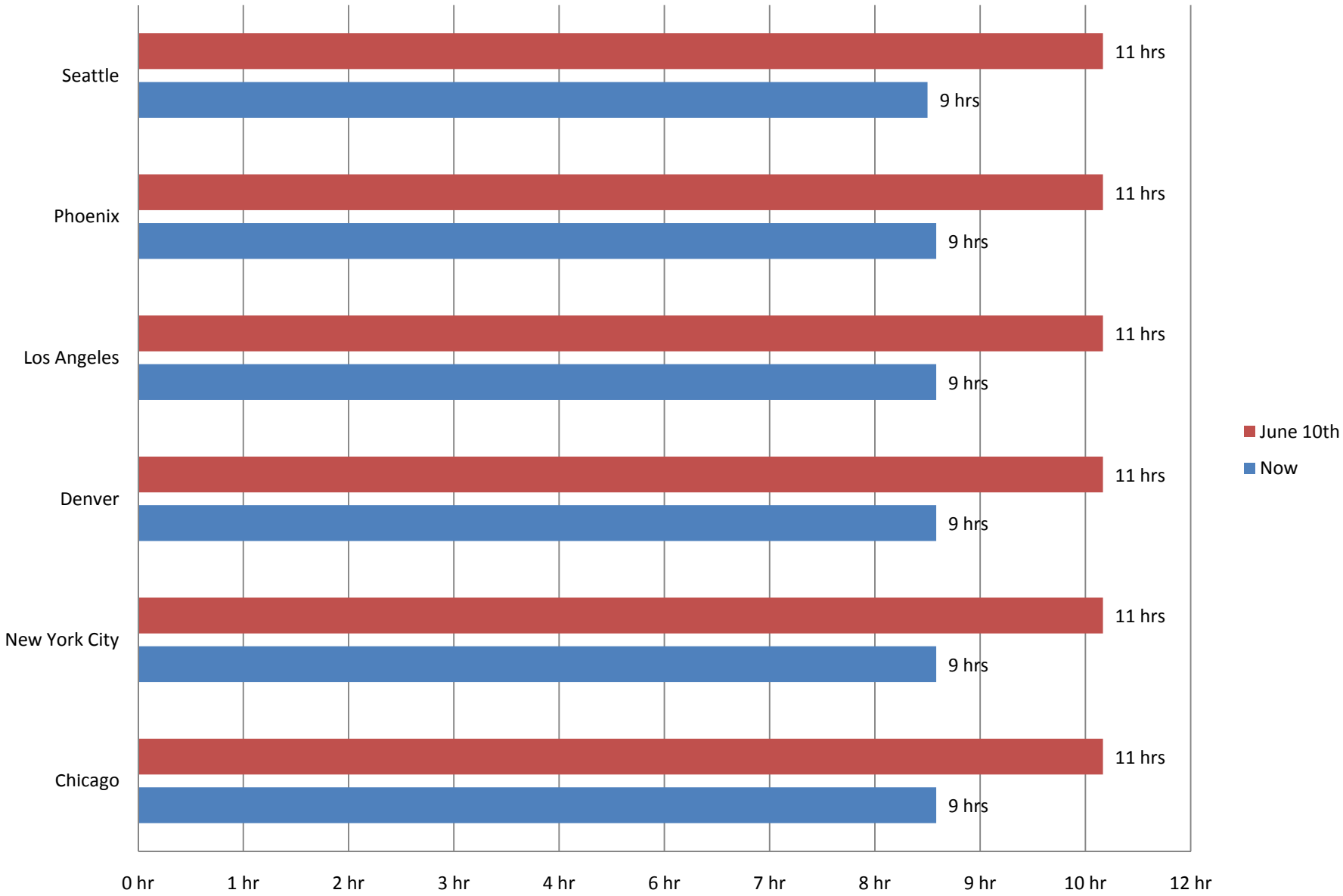
## Connection Times Decrease with Addition of 6:20 pm Arrival
